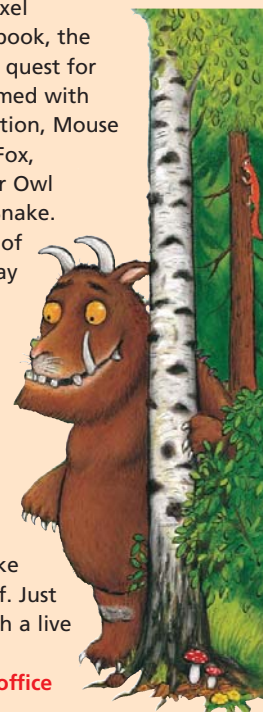
IF YOU GO DOWN TO THE WOODS TODAY . . .

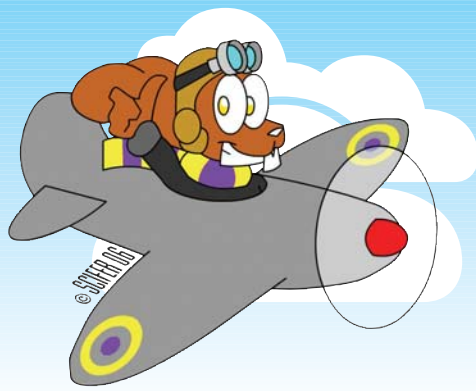
